Conclusions & experiences from Joint Operation

• Main results in Germany:

24 criminal offences because of withholding of salary (crew members) 4 administrative offences (missing ship patents, not submitted service record, life jacket not valid)

- Although during the 1st JOP there wasn't any transit traffic in Germany, the operation was successful
- Contact and data exchange with the temporary coordination centre of Mohács was without problems









Conclusions & experiences from Joint Operation

- The controls surrounding the ports and the river provided so far no specific results; but we expect during the 2nd JOP more traffic and perhaps some results
- We should try to use more intense the temporary coordination centre of Mohács (not only statistical data exchange)
