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## Joint Operation national tasks and methodology

#### **National tasks:**

- illegal migration, smuggling or trafficking in human beings
- Transport of dangerous goods
- Detections of tobacco smuggling
- Detections of smuggling of other dangerous products on board
- Organised theft from cargo vessels
- Detections of documents (false, forged, counterfeit)
- Detections of wanted persons in the crew or in passengers
- Controls of destination ports (during unloading suspicious ships)
- Controls on labour employment on members of crew

#### Methodology:

• "on the spot check"









### Forces used in Joint Operation

2 BCP's (Novi Sad - Ships from/to Croatia and Bezdan – Ships from/to Hungary)

- Authorities: Border police, Customs authority, Port authority
- Number of officials involved: 32
- Duty boats involved: 1

- DE TCC RS (exchange of information for the ships "Pezoto" and "Phonix", the Bulgarian flag)
