Romanian National Proposals for the next Joint Operation

PLANNING FOR THE 2ND JOINT OPERATION FROM JULY

- Single objective: **Actions against illegal migration and smuggling;**
- Predefined operational areas uncovered by surveillance capabilities of DARIF MS;
- Operational phase for minimum 5 days;
- Joint / mixed operational teams using FRONTEX procedures;

Romanian National Proposals for the next Joint Operation

TASKS AND METHODOLOGY

- Find, detect and control small boats patrolling by boat on duty in selected areas;
- Control in border check points on cruisers crews (Schengen Visa);
- Cross checks on non UE citizens enters and exits using seaman book / crew list;

- Barge Checking for overdraft (using draft survey procedures)

TEMPORARY COORDINATION CENTRE IN MOHÁCS

- Permanent contact with NCC to provide the joint operation teams with necessary information for the implementation of the mission;
- An interactive map with specific areas of interest should be useful;

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FRAMEWORK FOR OPERATIONAL PLAN

- The FOP plan should also specify the human and financial resources required, as well as identify the evaluation criteria thus providing a baseline against which progress can be assessed;
- A common data-base for flagged vessels/persons involved in illegal activities and a common scale of risk level should be a part of FOP;
- **DATA EXCHANGE FORM** is too complicate for use. On the first sheet only chapter regarding the checks carried out and information exchange are useful.
- A final JO report is mandatory.
