Joint Operation national tasks and methodology

(Chapter3 of Framework Operational Plan)

- 1. Facilitation of illegal immigration, trafficking in human beings, actions against illegal immigration
- 2. Synthetic drugs production and poly-drug trafficking in the EU
- 3. Detections of tobacco smuggling
- 4. Detections of smuggling of other dangerous products on board (weapon, armament and ammunition, radioactive materials)
- 5. Detections of wanted persons in the crew or in passengers
- 6. Search of cargo ships and shipload with sniffer dogs (particularly the container and/or truck carriers)









Forces used in Joint Operation

- Authorities involved: River police, Transport authority, The Customs
- Number of officials involved: 16
- Duty boats involved: 9
- Duty cars involved: 6

Summary of checks carried out during the operation:

Passenger cruise ships 10

Boats 9

Persons checked 55

Documents checked 52

Results:

No criminal offences were detected during the operation.

Petty offences were detected:

Transport Authority)









Examples of information exchange during Joint Operation

 Information about two vessels which were sailing through the Slovak republic. (When did they cross the Slovak borders and if they anchored in the Slovak part of the river Danube) Information sent to the German liason officer.
