Summary of suggestions to the next Joint Operation

- Should be multi purpose operation again, with less tasks than before - involving the Danube-Rhine-Main Canal
- More increased controls on illegal labour employment (exploitation)
- More searches on containers (criminal information is needed - importance of preliminary information - using SOCTA, IBISWEB)
- Tasks and methodology should be chosen by the countries again
- More effective use of the EUROPOL database - cross check on the available crew and passenger lists (sharing an excel sheet and all lists should be typed into it and forwarding to the EUROPOL officer)
- Another officer should be invited from the Interpol with mobile office
- Pre-operational phase should be applied if needed - should last for 1 month before the operation
- Joint operational groups should be made with the support of the Frontex - with guest officers

- We should improve the run of the Temporary Coordination Centre in Mohács make the information flow more effective - with one more officer in staff (at least 2 - 1 coordinator + 1 analyser)
- Framework Operational Plan was appropriate - no major changes required - but a situational picture of the member states should be stated in it
- Data exchange form should be divided into 2 parts (1st: only numbers - easy to summarize in excel, 2nd part: independent word sheet - with case descriptions..) - bilingual form is needed
- Quicker information flow, forwarding the daily operational results in 2 hours
- Using functional - special (police) email accounts
- Using a special application for real time information exchange on the controlled ships (by fundamental data) - other countries should see which ships were subject of the increased control in the net country...- making a database
